

## ***Upper Noe Rec Center Sidewalk Plants***

*Selected for their bright color, low maintenance and drought-resistance.*

### ***Bidens ferulifolia 'Blazing Glory'***

(commonly known as Apache beggarticks or fern-leaved beggartick) is native to the arid, rocky regions of Mexico and the southwestern United States, particularly Arizona. A fast-growing, heat-tolerant ornamental perennial that thrives in sunny, well-drained spots. It features fern-like foliage and bright yellow, daisy-like flowers with orange-red tips that bloom from late spring to fall, offering excellent, low-maintenance color.



### ***Felicia amelloides***

(Blue Daisy/Blue Marguerite) is native to South Africa. However, it is a very popular, water-wise, and fast-growing evergreen shrub in California landscapes, blooming with sky-blue flowers and yellow centers, primarily attracting pollinators in sun-drenched gardens.



### ***Limonium perezii***

(Perez's sea lavender) is native to the Canary Islands. It is specifically native to coastal areas and is widely cultivated for its large, purple, papery flowers, often used in dried arrangements.



### ***Salvia corrugata***

(commonly known as Corrugated Sage) is a perennial shrub native to the Andean montane regions of South America. It thrives in high-altitude, cool, and moist habitats, often found in cloud forests and on mountain slopes.



### ***Sisyrinchium bellum***

(Western blue-eyed grass) is a perennial plant in the iris family native to western North America, primarily California. It thrives in open, grassy areas, woodlands, and coastal bluffs.



### ***Salvia 'Marine Blue'***

(often listed as Salvia chamaedryoides 'Marine Blue') is a popular, drought-tolerant perennial shrub.
